Of course, everyone's situation is different. But, if you are frustrated, sad, or depressed I hope you can give yourself space/time and be kind to yourself. We can be hard on ourselves because we want to be the best for our dogs. That pressure/stress can take the fun away.

Also, having dogs in rehab is extra stressful. Weird as it may seem you may find working on their rehab exercises may help you to want to do agility again. Rehab exercises are short, tend to be easy to do correctly and your dog is probably going to be happy to do anything with you. Seeing them be happy can help you to be happy too.

Give yourself time away from dog agility if you think you need it. Do other things you enjoy doing with your dogs. To them agility is a game you play together. There might be another way you can be together and over time that may remind you why you liked doing agility in the first place.
